promote global aviation safety through continuous monitoring and determination of Member States' safety oversight and safety management capabilities.


#### USOAP ACTIVITIES

- <u>Audit & validation</u>: systematic and objective review of a State's effective implementation of the eight critical elements of a State safety oversight system and accident/incident investigation capabilities.
- <u>State Safety Programme Implementation Assessments (SSPIAs)</u>: to determine the maturity levels of the State's State Safety Programme (SSP) implementation and maintenance based on the results of the SSP PQs

7.005	CE 1	Has the State promulgated primary aviation legislation to facilitate the assistance of aircraft in distress in its territory in adherence to Article 25 of the Chicago Convention?
7.481	CE 6	Has the State arranged for the establishment and provision of SAR services within its territory and the areas where the State has accepted responsibility to provide SAR on a 24-hour basis in accordance with Annex 12 provisions?
7.487	CE 3	Does the SAR inspectorate have sufficient human resources to carry out its functions?
7.491	CE 3	Has the State established for SAR inspectors: a) job descriptions; b) minimum qualifications; and c) experience requirements?
7.499	CE 4	Is the training programme appropriately implemented for SAR inspectors?





#### AFI SAR EI BY CRITICAL ELEMENT

The AFI SAR system weakness areas reside in the training and qualification of technical personnel, approval of industry activities, surveillance and resolution of deficiencies.

7.537	Does the State ensure that the rescue coordination centre (RCC) and, as appropriate, rescue sub- centre (RSC), is staffed 24 hours a day by trained personnel proficient in the use of the English language?	<ul> <li>No mechanism to ensure effective implementation of the requirements for RCC/RSC to be staffed 24 hours a day by trained personnel proficient in the use of the English language.</li> <li>No SAR inspectorate established.</li> </ul>

7.545	Does the State ensure that SAR personnel are regularly trained and that appropriate SAR exercises are arranged?	<ul> <li>No documented process established for the determination of operational staff requirements.</li> <li>ineffective mechanism to ensure the effective implementation SAR training programme.</li> <li>No SAR exercises arranged.</li> </ul>



### ----- Addressing SAR findings

Findings from a USOAP CMA activity is addressed through the development, submission, validation and effective implementation of a corrective action plan (CAP).

### > 6 Criteria for the development of an effective CAP.

**1.** *Relevant* – CAPs should address the issues and requirements related to the finding and corresponding PQ and critical element (CE).

2. *Comprehensive* – CAPs should be complete; including all elements or aspects associated with the finding.

3. **Detailed** – CAPs should be laid out in a step-by-step approach, as required, to outline the implementation process.

4. *Specific* – CAPs should identify who will do what, when, in coordination with the responsible office or entity.

5. *Realistic* – CAPs should be realistic in terms of contents and implementation timelines.

6. *Consistent* – CAPs should be consistent in relation to other CAPs and with the State self-assessment.



### ----- Addressing SAR findings

### > Tips to develop effective CAP for SAR findings

- ✓ CAP development is a teamwork: Need for expertly brainstorming to agree on the most suitable actions
- ✓ Use of action verbs is highly recommended
- ✓ Generic verbs such as: ensure, observe, make sure, think about etc. are not recommended
- ✓ Break down large action items into smaller, more manageable elements.
- ✓ Describe each proposed action in a clear and detailed manner.
- ✓ List the step-by-step corrective actions in the correct sequential and/or chronological order
- Provide a good and clear working plan and adequate detail for the implementation of each step of the proposed corrective actions.
- ✓ For findings associated with CEs 6, 7 and 8, provide necessary details (i.e. evidences and examples) on implemented requirements and procedures.
- ✓ Use a table template similar to that of the USOAP CMA Online Framework (OLF) to ensure consistency with format.
- ✓ Seek advice from your respective accredited ICAO regional office whenever necessary
